When Delphi started acting differently, Aliki thought maybe it was arthritis. But, it turns out, it was something completely different."I found out that Delphi had pyometra, which I had never even heard of," Aliki says. "Things progressed quickly and ended up so bad I needed to see an emergency vet."

The cost of surgery was very high, though. Without it, Delphi wouldn't make it. Pyometra is a uterine infection that can be fatal without treatment. "I went home in a panic and started researching any possible options and calling everywhere ... I could reach to inquire about options," added Aliki. When a search turned up Spay Illinois, she called. It was a last-ditch effort that turned everything around for Delphi and her mom.

"The receptionist seemed genuinely concerned for Delphi's well-being," says Aliki. "She was extremely patient and understanding with me. I cannot express the level of comfort that brought me or the amount of relief I felt when I was able to get my baby scheduled for the next morning."

Aliki was terrified on the way in the next day, but when staff greeted her and treated her and her bestie "like family," that helped. Soon, Aliki would hear that her baby had made it through just fine

Now, she lets people know how she feels about Spay Illinois. "I would tell [others] that these people truly love animals and that I could think of no better place to take your pet. I would tell them that they saved my dog's life."







We are excited to give you a little peek at our upcoming new clinic! Later this year, we will open a new 16,000 sq ft clinic with all our services under one roof! Some of the features of our new location will include five wellness exam rooms, an expanded call center, a dental suite with two dental tables, a six-table spay/neuter surgical suite, an in-house lab and pharmacy, and a special surgery suite for foreign body, soft tissue, and TPLO surgeries as well. 
